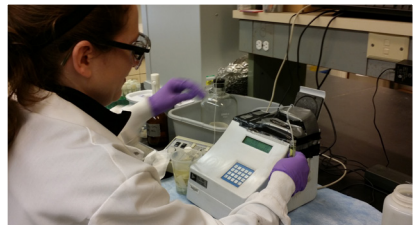
Laboratory Technicians; full-time summer 2022

Employee will be responsible for conducting analyses on water quality samples in the MU Limnology Laboratory. Employee may be called upon for occasional field days (no overnights). Previous chemistry lab experience desired, but not required. Pay rate starting at \$11/hour.
