Duties: Assist fisheries biologists with electrofishing, netting, trot lining and other field work on lakes, rivers and streams. Assist with aquatic habitat improvement projects. Assist with management of aquatic and terrestrial vegetation in and around public fishing impoundments, using herbicide and brush cutters. Keep vehicles, boats, and storage facilities clean. Perform basic maintenance on equipment. Other duties as assigned.

Other information: Position located at the St. Louis Regional Office (Busch C.A.) in St. Charles. Hours are typically 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, though sampling trips are often long days. Overnight trips to sampling locations are sometimes necessary (expenses paid by MDC). Occasional weekend duty may be requested. Field work is often performed during adverse weather (extreme heat, rain, rough water, etc.) and in uncomfortable conditions (carrying heavy gear, wearing chest waders, on rough terrain etc.).
